OUR STORY

The Seven Stars Foundation, Inc. was established on February 7th, 2007, in honor of Morphine One-Two, a US marine corps CH-46 Casevac helicopter, that was shot down in Karmah, Iraq after completing a medi-vac operation. All seven crew members on board perished.
